Is MRI safe?

At this time, there are no known significant health risks associated with repeated exposure to the magnetic field or radio waves used in MRI. Unlike X-rays or CT scans, MRI does not use radiation.

Will I receive compensation?

- Participants will receive \$75 (\$15/hour for approximately 5 hours)
- Children will receive an additional prize valued at \$15.
